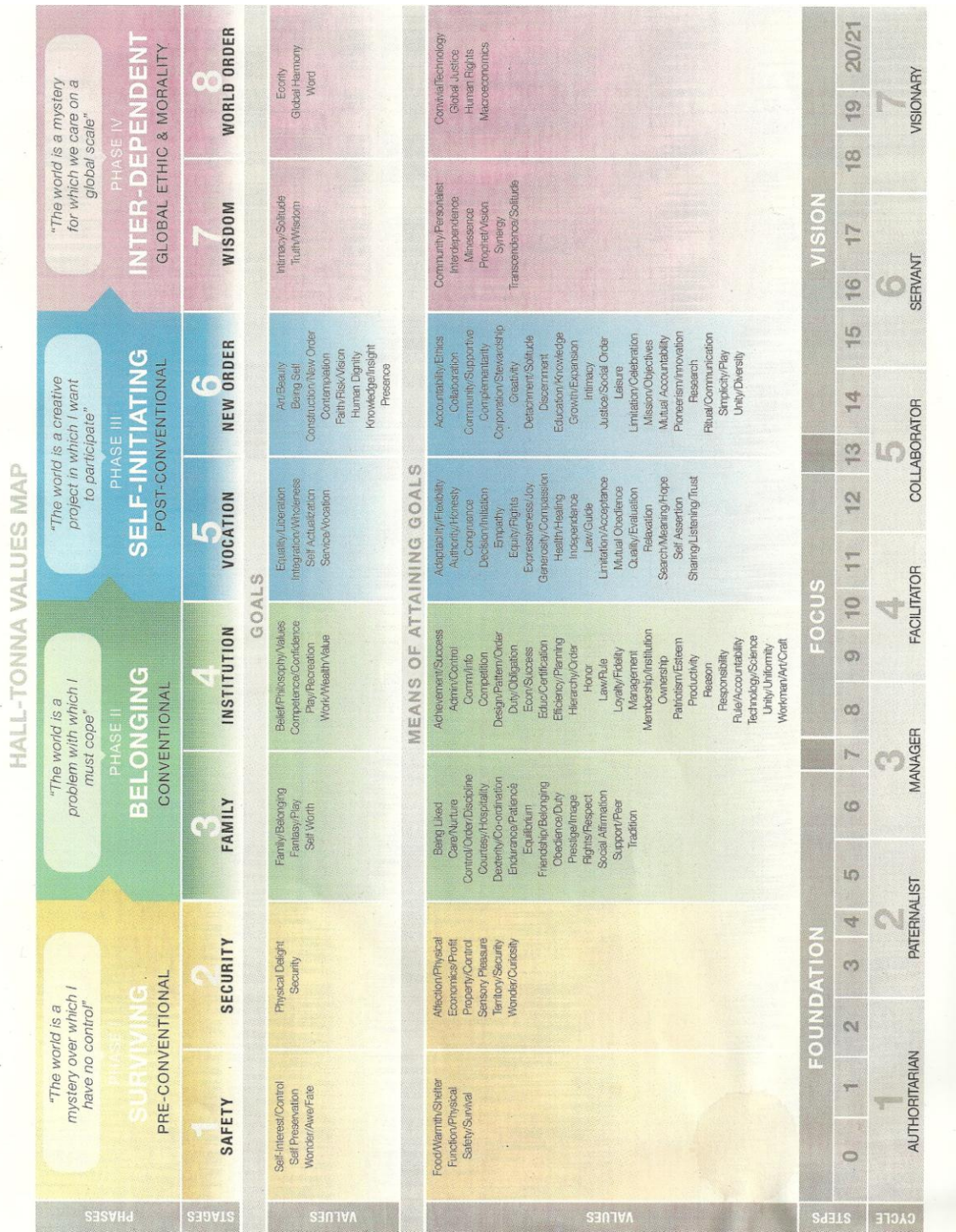


Annex 1: Values Distribution Map
